### How has sober living benefited you?

"Sober living has been essential to building a foundation of recovery –that I'm still working on... but being able to be introduced to meetings and a sober support system, it is essential, really, to maintain my sobriety."

### Being in a house with other women in sobriety how does that support you?

"That is incredible. Most of these women have become family, they're not just, you know, another face in recovery. And even through our ups and downs we find a way to meet each other in the middle and we're really encouraging of each other.

There isn't a single time when somebody is having a bad day or something traumatic happens in our lives that we aren't there for each other to build each other up and help us make it through another 24 hours sober...and that is really essential, especially when you're first being introduced to sobriety and recovery and really trying to make it through... you can't do it alone and you never have to here....and that has been amazing!"
